For a farm experience, Cambinata Yabbies will guide you through their yabby processing and on request can show you other aspects of their farming operation of cropping, livestock and bees. Get up close with the flock at Emu Essence Farm and you can even join an emu egg hunt during laying season. Lake Dumbleyung is the largest lake in WA's southwest at 13km long, 6.5km wide and is thought to be derived from the Aboriginal word 'Dambeling' meaning large lake or sea. Experience the natural beauty of a sunset or sunrise at Pussy Cat Hill, take a picnic or venture down to the lake shore to walk, paddle or boat depending on varying water levels.

The Bluebird Precinct tells the incredible story of how Donald Campbell made world record history on Lake Dumbleyung in 1964 by breaking both land and water speed records in one year - a feat that has never been achieved before or since. A replica of Donald Campbell's 'Bluebird' boat can be viewed 24hrs a day in the Dumbleyung Townsite, while passers at night will be drawn to the brilliant illumination of the replica and a unique sculpture of Donald Campbell made from chicken wire!
